# The Michael Evan Jurist Bursary International Service Trip Application Form Due: September 26, 2016

**Please note: This year the Bursary is only available to those students participating in the  
*Me to We China Trip to Kenya March 2017***

This bursary was created by Paul and Vesna Jurist in memory of their son, Michael (1985 – 2007). It is available to students with financial need who wish to take part in an international service project as a means of broadening their horizons and promoting global citizenry.

All applications are reviewed based on the following criteria: (i) the strength of the boy's application and the articulation of his interest, (ii) the support of his Senior House Adviser, (iii) financial need, (iv) grade level (FY, IB1 and IB2) and (v) the determination by the College's senior academic and student life personnel. The number of recipients is determined by the transfer that the College receives from the endowed fund for this purpose. It is conceivable that in some years there may be more than one recipient. Two \$2,250.00 bursaries will be awarded this year.

A member of the class of 2003, Michael attended UCC for 11 years and was an active member of the student body. He was an excellent student, a gifted tennis player and a benevolent leader and mentor to his charges in McHugh's. Michael had a passion for travel and a desire to experience other cultures and to raise the collective consciousness of his peers to international issues.
