**RISK MANAGEMENT CHART**

Category of Risk (where applicable)	Description of Risk and Plan for Mitigation
Travel	All participants will be walking a designated 7Km route with UCC teachers and walk organizers, escorted by Metro Toronto Police along with a support first aid vehicle. After the walk, the boys will return to the College by school bus.
Health and Safety	Boys need to be in good health to be able to walk the 7km route. Safety is provided by UCC faculty, walk organizers and Metro Toronto police officers. Boys must follow the guidance and direction of all adult supervisors. A meal and snacks will be provided by the walk organizers and boys with food allergies and sensitivities must bring along epi-pens and eat foods that are deemed appropriate by their physicians.
Environmental	Weather could be anything from snow, to rain, to hot and sunny so participants should bring proper attire for any situation – including rain gear, sunscreen, hats, etc. Appropriate footwear and outdoor wear are critical so please consult weather conditions for the day.
